Mason & Hamlin reed organ restored in fall, 2021 by Richard Carroll

This organ was secured by George and Cookie Kaizar for the Historical Society of Washington Twp. in mid 1980's. It was not playable, but was bought to serve as church furniture when the Bunker Hill Presbyterian Church was moved to the Olde Stone House Village in about 1985.

The piano currently in the church was donated by Christine Firth Walsh to provide music during the June anniversary services after the church was relocated. Christine had played on that piano as a child.

When the church was moved to the Village, the small old electronic organ was moved into the new church on Greentree Road and was used for several years until it was replaced by a much larger electronic organ.
